One, and only ONE name given under Heaven By which men can be saved.

Question: Do you know that name?

The scriptures make that abundantly clear, and here is that scripture.

For there is no other Name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Neither is there salvation in any other. Acts 4 and verse 12. KJV

Romans 10 and verse 9 says;

If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in your heart, that God raised him from the dead, you shall be saved.

Salvation then is available to all, according to that passage. It would seem that all that is required, is to utter a few words and believe, and you're home. Confession and belief.-----REALLY?

In the gospel of john chapter six and verse 44 the scripture says, and I quote" No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day."

In verse 45 of chapter 6 we find the following words written: It is written in the prophets, and they shall all be taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and has learned of the Father, cometh unto me.

Indicating, the Father being involved in the process of salvation, no need to make any confession, first we must believe in the resurrection, and was taught by God to be raised up on the last day, by the messiah. BUT!!! There is some confusion here. First God must teach us and then we can come to the Son. But God was not on the earth, Emmanu'el/ Jesus was.

Here is the answer: The English translators---- and the people who tamper with the scriptures, are responsible for the confusion. The Prophecy actually says and I quote " And they shall all be

taught by YHVH" not God. The English word God was never inspired by YHVH, all the scriptures were inspired by none other than YHVH Himself.

He gave his name to Moses, and here is what He said beginning in Exodus Chapter 3 and verse 4: and when YHVH saw that (He) Moses had turned aside to see, Elohim called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses, and he said Here I am.

Verse 6 reads; moreover He said, I AM the Elohim of thy Father, the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac the Elohim of Jacob------. From the memorial scroll, the CJB and the ISR, renders it the same way. And the Aramaic text likewise.

NOTE; The word God was never inspired by our Creator, as I pointed out above, the translators and the people who tampered with the scriptures are responsible for the confusion.

Note; Confession has nothing to do with being saved, it's the name, the one and only name. We must now address the One and only name by which we can be saved, the scripture clearly teaches salvation cannot be found in any other name.

Before I go on to prove the importance of the name, let me share some scriptures with you, that will clearly show, only those who are being called have access to the truth. Emmanu'el in John 17 and verse 9 prayed. *I pray not for the world but for those whom thou hast given me for they are thine.*

More proof that we must first be called by the Father, before we can come to the Son. In verse 16 of chapter14: he said; *and I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another comforter, that he may abide with you forever. 17: even the spirit of truth; which the world cannot receive.* (the world is not invited). And there you have it; line upon line, precept upon precept, here a little and there a little right from the pages of your bible. Not from any man!

Comment: confessing with your mouth is another fraudulent passage inserted into the words of your bible. If confession was all that is required, the whole world would have access to salvation. Messiah says no, the world does not.

Let's get back to the name.

In the gospel of Matthew the birth of the messiah is recorded with two different names for the messiah. That's the first major issue we discover, obviously there is a major problem right there. The scriptures make it abundantly clear that there is only one name.

Question: who is responsible for this madness, and how do we go about the business of finding the truth. The answer is found in the gospel of John and it reads as follows;

Sanctify them by thy truth thy Word is truth. John 17:17

Now that we have the necessary information, lets us now turn to His **Words**. In the New Testament in the gospel of Matthew chapter 1 and verse 21 the gospel writer recorded the following words. *And she shall bring forth a Son and thou shall call his name Jesus*. In verse 20 Joseph was given the name Jesus.

Question: Did an angel speak to Joseph in English and actually say JESUS? NONESENSE

No he did not, and here are the reasons why. There is no "J" letter in the Hebrew language, no "J" sound in the Hebrew language no "J" letter in the English language until after the 1611 printing of the King James Bible.

That said, we find a major lie with the name Jesus. No angel can come from heaven with any other name. YHVH told the Prophet Isaiah Emmanu'el and also said, his Mother would call him Emmanu'el, not they. And further more The scripture from Isaiah says YHVH HIMSELF WOULD BE THAT CHILD.

The English translators of the scripture tell us Emmanu'el means God with us. The Creator's name cannot be Jesus. I AM spelled his name for Moses on Mt Sinai and HE used four Hebrew words rendered in English YUD HEH VAV HEH. The English translation of the Aramaic text renders the name Yeshua, instead of Jesus

In verse 23 of Matthew chapter 1 we find that passage quoted by the gospel writer, and it reads as follows; behold a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a Son, and "they" shall call his name Emmanu'el. Who is "They?"

Here is the other lie recorded by the English translators; In verse 22 that passage reads; now all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet. A concordance check at this time reveals that the name Jesus does not appear in any prophecy in the O/T.

NOTE: Another lie recorded by the people who tampered with the scriptures. The prophecy says Emmanu'el.

Comment; there you have the proof; there was never ever a Jesus Christ from Nazareth. The name Christian cannot be found in any of the Gospel accounts of the messiah's Ministry.

Matthew chapter two and verse twenty three reads as follows; And he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, he shall be called a Nazarene.

P.S. the Apostle Sha'ul/ Saul/Paul was known as the ringleader of the sect of the Nazarenes. NOT THE CHRISTIANS!
